  - **The Role of Universities in Society** – Presentation of a recent study by the Norwegian Research Council looking at the value creation of 5 major institutions.
  - **Policy Drivers & Strategic Networks** - Presentation on key policy documents e.g. EU2020 Strategy, Innovation Union, European Education Area etc. as a starting point for discussions. Introduction of the role of Technology platforms and activities to date (EATiP, EFTP)
- Workshop Session: **Future Needs: Knowledge Management Challenges and the role of educators** (facilitated interactive session)
- **Showcasing new resources for teaching**, with examples of a selection of tools and approaches that are useful for creating e-learning content and which might help partners to enrich their teaching and to enhance motivation and learning success of their students; integrating the latest developments in RTD into Training Programmes; and innovative games to teach languages.
